We invite all parents / carers to come and celebrate our children's sporting achievements.

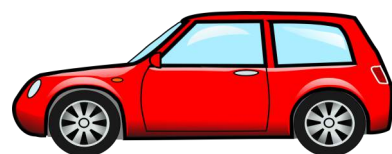


Parking on Maple Drive


