

Parent Survey Outcome

Prior to half term, I sent a survey to parents / carers about the option to collect your child(ren) early on the last day of term.

As the majority of parents indicated that they would like the option to collect their children at 1:10pm on the last day of term, we will be offering two pick up times. These will be 1:10pm and 3:10pm.

1:10pm pick up time will take place on the school yard as normal with gates closing at 1:20pm.

Children not being picked up between 1:10pm and 1:20pm will remain in their classroom or other area of school until 3:10pm.

Please do not turn up between 1:20pm and 3:10pm to collect your children from main reception.

No other pick up times will be available unless a medical appointment is in place for your child or they are unwell and need collecting.

A letter will be sent home soon where you will need to send the reply slip back to indicate whether your child will be collected at 1:10pm or 3:10pm.
